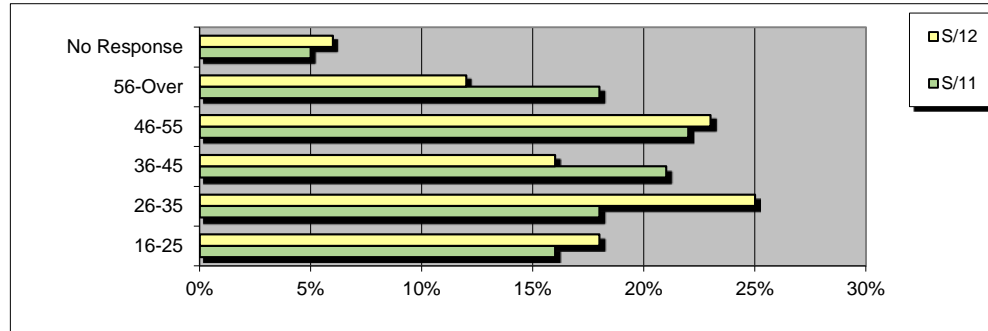

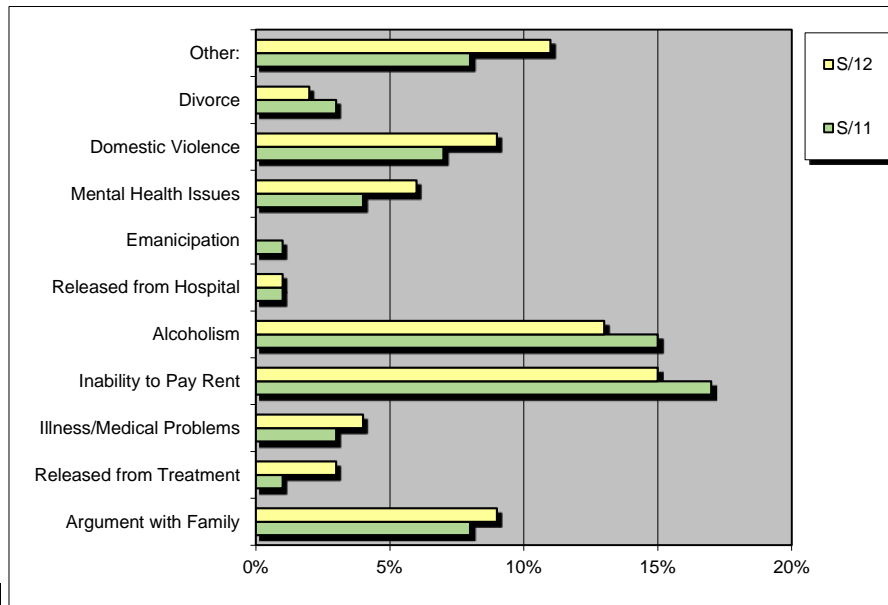

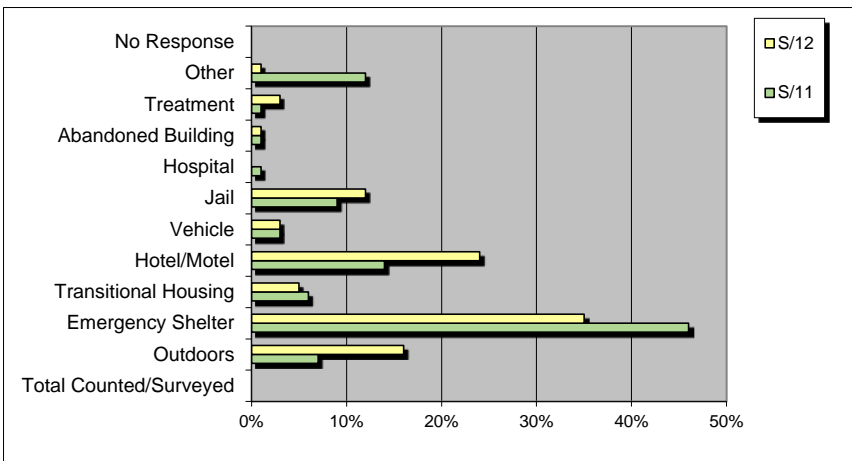

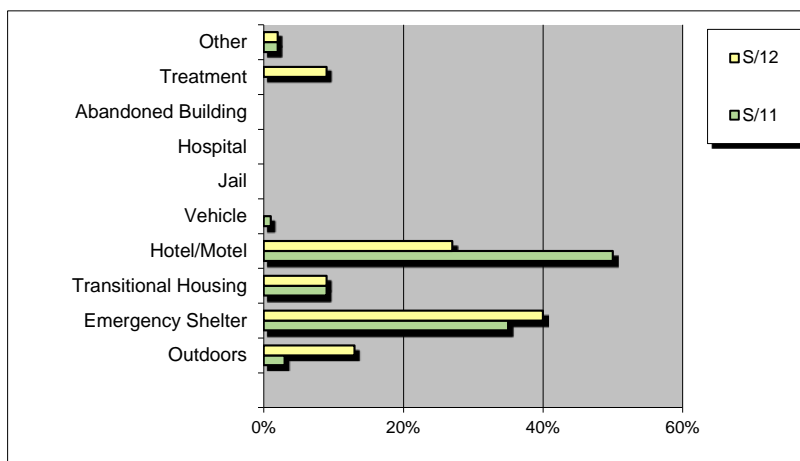

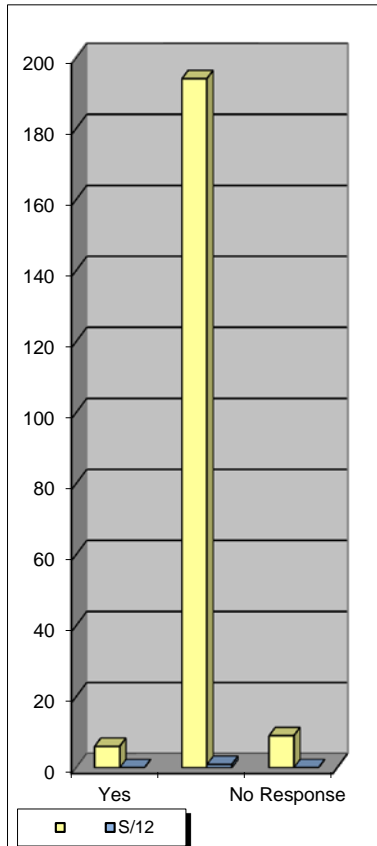

Were you activated into active duty as a member of the National Guard or as a Reservist?

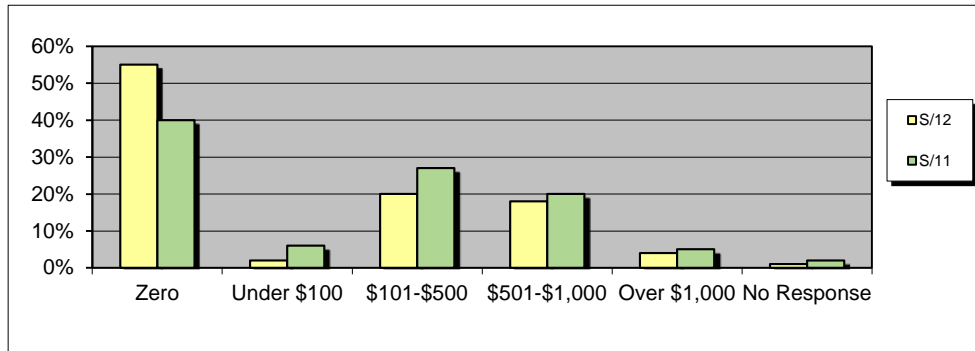

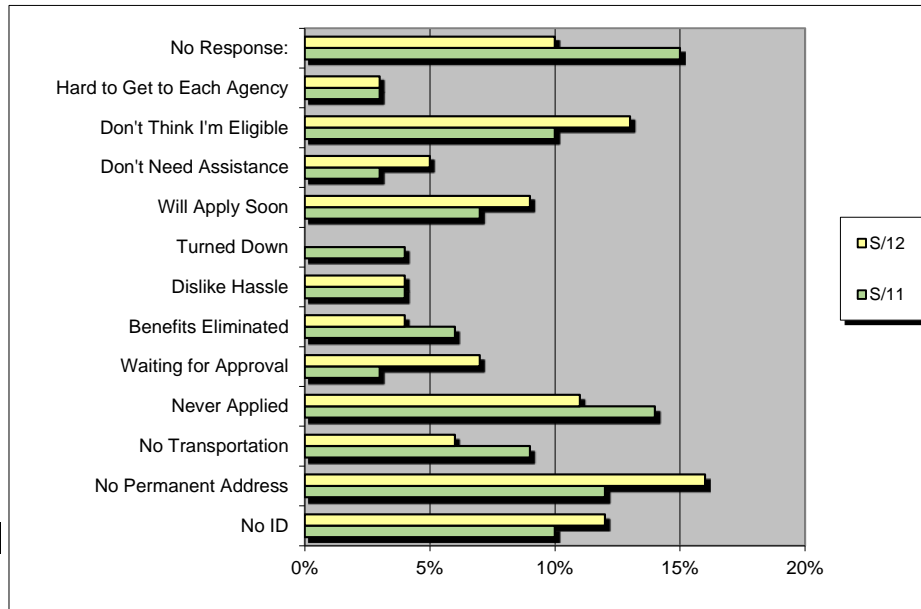

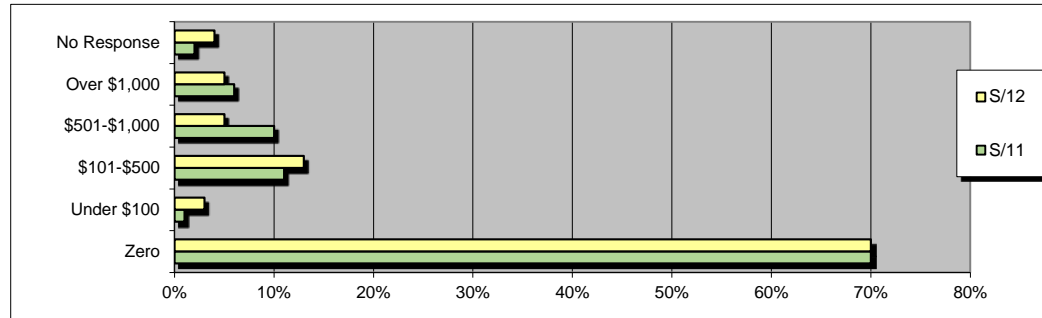

How much monthly income do you receive

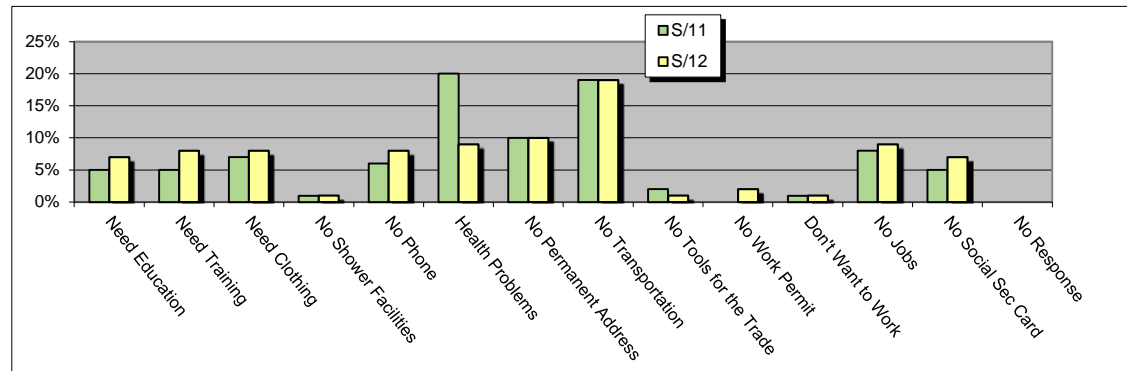
