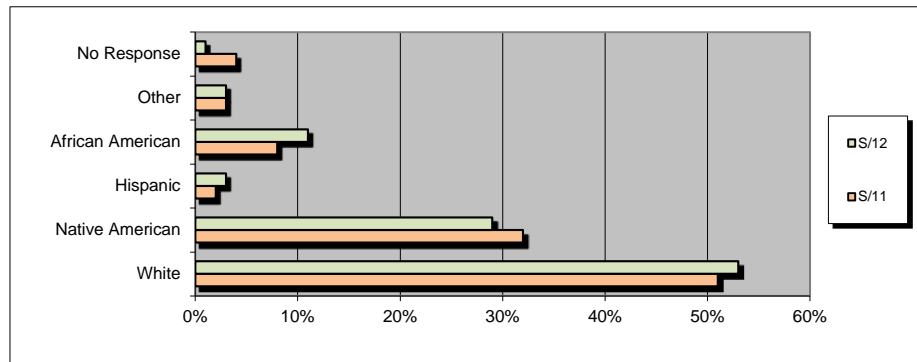

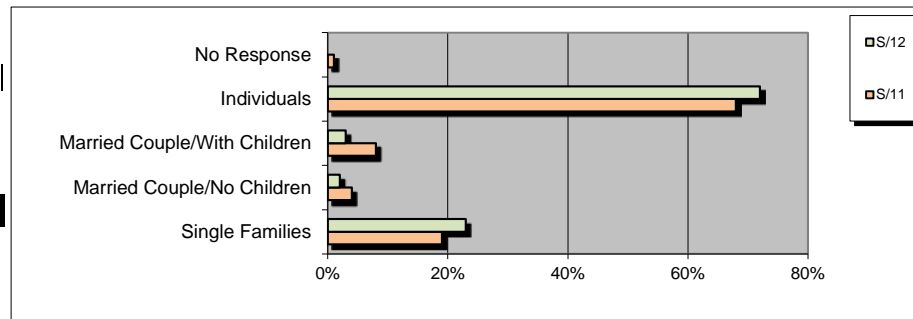

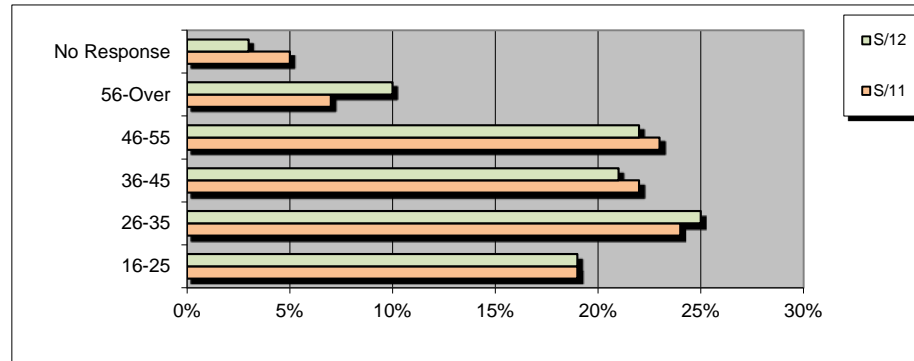

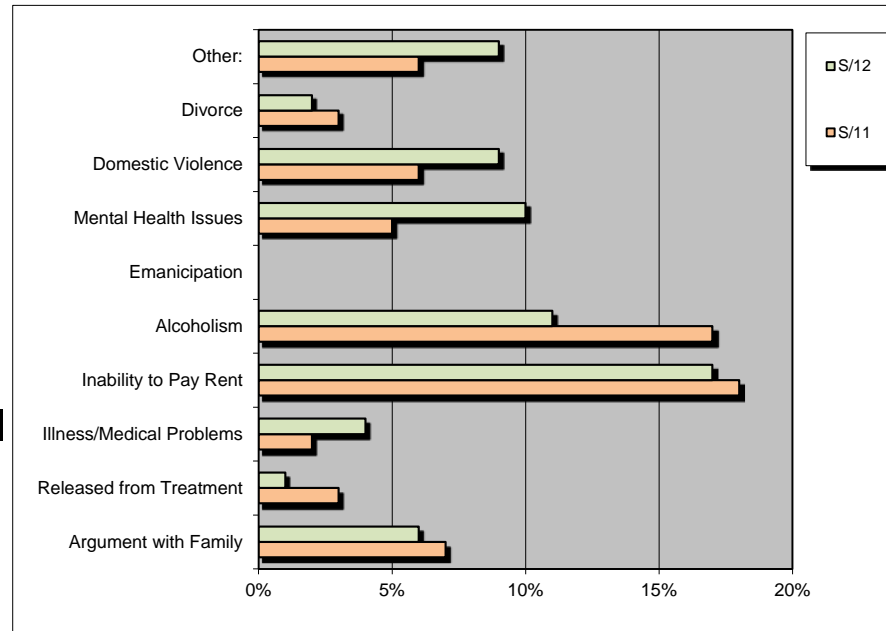

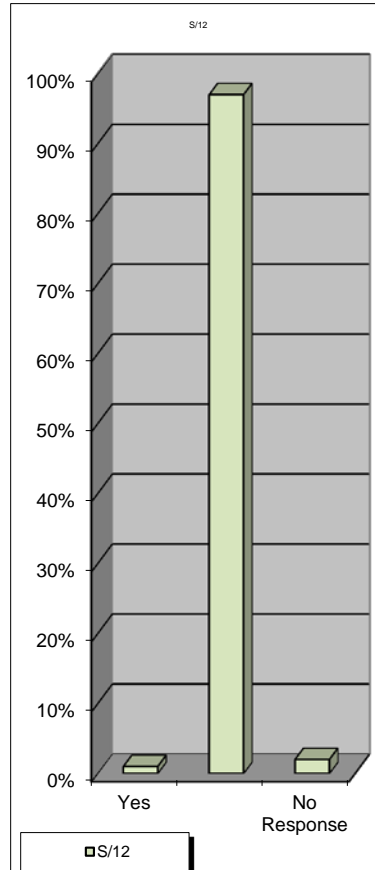
**Have you Served in the Armed Forces?

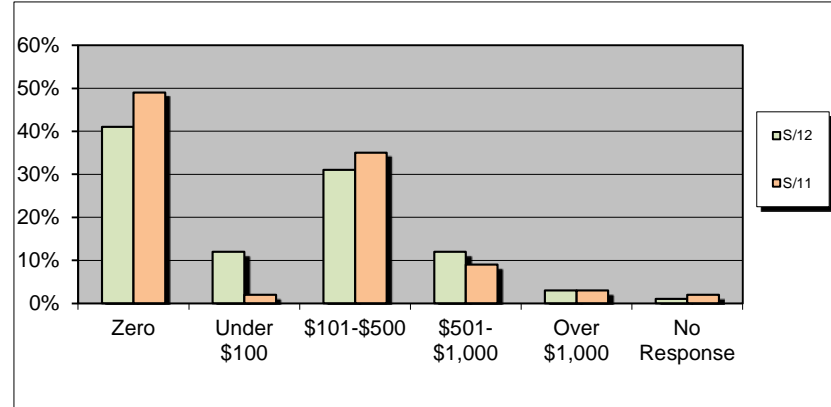

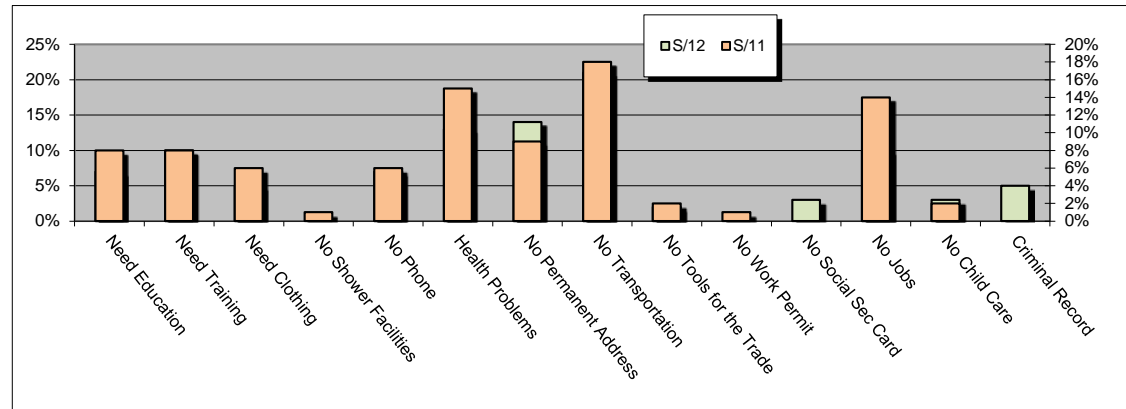
